

The Maddog Strong Foundation Giving Tree Dedication Guideline Information

Please keep in mind that this event honors Organ and Tissue Donors and their Families. Many of those in attendance may be transplant recipients who wish to honor donors, but who are immunocompromised. These requested measures are meant to keep those at greatest risk feel safe in attending this event. Thank you for your cooperation!

1. Everyone must wear a mask when arriving and departing the event.
2. Masks must be worn when groups (i.e., families who come together) cannot maintain six feet of social distance from other individuals or groups.
3. All guests must self-assess whether they should attend the event by answering the questions below before arriving at the event, and if a guest answers "yes" to any of the questions, they should remain home.

HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE FOR WELLNESS SCREEN RELATED TO COVID-19

The Maddog Strong Foundation and the Frankfort Square Park District are committed to the safety of employees, patrons, and community. Event guests are required to self-assess using these questions prior to coming on-site. If the answer is "yes" to any question, please do not come on-site to prevent the spread of illness.

- Do you have a fever of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher?
- Do you have a cough?
- Do you have a sore throat?
- Have you been experiencing difficulty breathing or shortness of breath?
- Do you have muscle aches?
- Have you had a new or unusual headache (e.g., not typical to the individual)?
- Have you noticed a new loss of taste or loss of smell?
- Have you been experiencing chills or rigors (i.e., a sudden feeling of cold with shivering accompanied by a rise in temperature)?
- Do you have any gastrointestinal concerns (e.g., abdominal pain, vomiting, diarrhea)?
- Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Is anyone in your household displaying any symptoms (as listed above) of COVID-19?
- To the best of your knowledge, in the last 14 days, have you come into close contact* with anyone who has tested positive for or been diagnosed with COVID-19?

By coming to this event, you acknowledge that you have in fact conducted this self-assessment, and the information provided is true and accurate to the best of your current knowledge and beliefs.

*Close contact includes household contacts, intimate contacts, or contacts within 6 feet for 15 minutes or longer (10 minutes or longer for ambulatory care services) unless wearing an N95 mask during period of contact.

4. Inclement Weather: Should weather conditions result in an official hazardous lightening, or other dangerous weather warning, alert, guests will be asked to return to their vehicles until an all clear is issued.
5. Maddog Strong Youth Ambassadors will be available to guide and assists guests with any needs as well as to make sure social distancing and mask guidelines are followed.
6. Should the event reach an attendance capacity that is prohibitive of appropriate social distancing, guests may be denied admission to the event.
