We have provided a health questionnaire that is also available on the COVID-19 tab on the Park District's website, www.fspd.org. Participants are required to employ the health questionnaire steps, self-assessing prior to attendance at any Park District activity. If you or your child show any symptoms, it is absolutely essential you stay home, not risking exposure to other participants or staff. We understand completely that symptoms can mirror seasonal allergies, flu, and even the common cold, making it even more important that we act proactively if any symptoms are present.

We want to promote these good practices to provide a sustainable opportunity, and to that end, any participant absent from class will receive a credit for the value of that session. Please notify us of absence, and we will post a credit for that day's class to your account.

In the event of a positive case, the Park District will institute necessary program closure, working with available resources to notify any that could have potential exposure. Let's do all we can to avoid this action.
