

Community Group Minimum Guidelines

Please note that per Frankfort Square Park District Ordinance 21-08-333, community groups are responsible for establishing and enforcing their own health and safety requirements.

The following are minimum general standards for groups, and are subject to change per State and local activity-specific direction from professional associations, DCEO, IDPH, and CDC.

The Governor placed the entire state of Illinois under a mandatory mask mandate effective August 30, 2021. This mandate requires all individuals over the age of 2, regardless of vaccination status, to wear a mask in indoor public settings for the indefinite future.

Situations where an individual cannot wear a mask should be handled by groups on a case by case basis. PDRMA, the Park District's risk management agency, has provided guidance that a reasonable accommodation is one that does not allow a person to come within 6 feet of others without a mask during the pandemic, as that likely creates a direct threat of safety to the individual with a mask as well as to the people with whom the individual comes into close contact.

Participant Guidelines

- Please monitor your family's health; if anyone is sick, please do not attend and notify your group/organization leader.
- Prior to arrival, each individual is responsible for completing our health questionnaire that is posted on the fspd.org website. If the answer is "yes" to any of the questions, please do not attend. <https://www.fspd.org/rccms/wp-content/uploads/2020/07/Health-Questionnaire.pdf>
- All group members must arrive at the facility wearing a face covering.
- Indoors, face coverings must be worn at all times.
- Participants must be socially distanced (6 feet) throughout the gathering.
- Multiple groups must be socially distanced at least 30 feet apart and not interact.
- No snacks; Participants may bring their own clearly labeled water bottle. Water fountains are not available for use.
- Keep personal belongings at least 6 feet away from other's personal belongings.
- Avoid touching facility accessories not necessary for your usage.
- Sanitize hands regularly.

Facility Usage Contact Responsibilities

- Complete the facility usage procedure, including forms, guidelines, and designate an individual to be on-site monitoring compliance with guidelines and available by phone for questions.
- If there are multiple meeting dates, please include compliance individual and contact number for each date.
- Maintain an attendance log.
- Immediately contact the Park District at (815) 469-3524 if one of your attendees tests positive for COVID-19.
